


### MEDIAN ASSESSED PROPERTY VALUE - CHESTER COUNTY




### POSSIBLE PREDICTED COLLEGE READINESS SCORES



### COLLEGE READINESS – US NEWS MEDIAN ASSESSMENT VALUE




## COLLEGE READINESS – US NEWS MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME




■ Median Household Income






